Please take your empty containers and the refill shop will fill them for you. They are a profit free organisation and so sell at cost price, just with a small round-up to cover costs of any spills.

#### Silsden supporting families in Liberia

Because of the large numbers wanting to attend they were split into two groups. The first group have just graduated, and the second group will start after Easter. However, the first group are eager to do more moving on to more advanced sewing and textiles.
