

This Sunday's Gathering Service

Our Gathering Service this Sunday is on Environment Sunday, which will be our theme for the day. This is also a time when churches are encouraged to do a count of all the nature they can find in the churchyard from plants, to bugs and other wildlife. This is called the Churches Count on Nature. After the Gathering, It would be wonderful if as many people as possible to join me in the churchyard for an hour to help count everything we can see in the churchyard. Those attending the Communion service can also join us once the service has finished.

To help with the counting, we will use the Inaturalist app to take photos of what we see and then record it (type 'Inaturalist' into the app store for your phone). Once you have downloaded the app, search under projects for St James Silsden Churchyard Count 2025. If you don't want to download the app, either team up with someone who does, or I will be around to capture your findings on the app. The results of the count will help organisations keep track of national trends and also help us with managing our churchyard for wildlife in the future. I'm looking forward to seeing how many species we can find!

This family-friendly exhibition features a wealth of rare items from the British Museum and local treasures from the collections of Bradford District Museums and Galleries
