

Repair Cafe

The next Silsden Repair Cafe is on Saturday 16 August, at the Methodist Church - between 9.30am and noon.

Also Climate Action Silsden hold a refill shop at every Repair Café. They stock Miniml (now based in Silsden!) household and personal care products, (all products are Vegan, Cruelty Free and Paraben Free and contain no synthetic dyes or perfumes).

The liquids available are washing up liquid, laundry detergent, fabric conditioner, multi-surface cleaner, toilet cleaner, floor cleaner, hand soap, bubble bath / shower gel, shampoo and hair conditioner. Please take your empty containers and the refill shop will fill them for you. They are a profit-free organisation and so sell at cost price, just with a small round-up to cover costs of any spills.

They have 21 single rooms, 6 twin-bedded rooms, 5 double-bedded rooms and a triple-bedded room.

Standard weekend adult rate with full board is £174.50 (£87.25 per night)
Standard mid-week adult rate with full board is £338.00 (£84.50 per night)

En suite supplement - £11 per person per night including children 5 years of age and over. (£196.50 for a weekend per an adult & £382.00 for a mid-week programme per an adult)

Day visitor's rates agreed on request

Discounts

Children under 5 are free

Children 5 - 7 years old 70% reduction

Children 8 - 11 years old 50% reduction

Children 12 - 16 years old 30% reduction

Full time students 30% reduction

Single parent families 10% reduction in total cost

Carers 20% reduction in their cost

Scargill weekend programmes run from 4pm on Friday to 2pm on Sunday, and mid-week programmes run from 4pm on Monday to 10am on Friday.
