

The next Silsden Repair Cafe is on Saturday 20 September, at Silsden Methodist Church - between 9.30am and noon.

Climate Action Silsden hold a refill shop at the Repair Café. They stock Miniml (now based in Silsden!) household and personal care products, (all products are Vegan, Cruelty Free and Paraben Free and contain no synthetic dyes or perfumes).

The liquids available are:- washing up liquid, laundry detergent, fabric conditioner, multi-surface cleaner, toilet cleaner, floor cleaner, hand soap, bubble bath, shower gel, shampoo and hair conditioner. Please take your empty containers and the refill shop will fill them for you. They are a profit-free organisation and so sell at cost price, just with a small round-up to cover costs of any spills.

#### The Sudan Link

From the Diocese of Leeds Website

Leeds Diocese is linked with the Episcopal Church in Sudan. That link opens a window on another part of the world helping to widen our horizons. The spirit of the link is partnership. Together we are members of the Body of Christ, so the link works both ways:

- We receive as much as we give
- We respect each other
- We listen to each other
- We pray for each other
- We work on shared tasks

We aim to support and encourage our brothers and sisters who feel marginalised and oppressed in their own country, yet maintain their faith in Christ with great courage.

By staying committed to the Church in Sudan we find we understand more about the church overseas than if we just follow wherever current headlines take us. We allow their lives to challenge us about how we live day to day, and how we can be better followers of Christ.

#### The War in Sudan

In April 2023 civil war erupted between the Sudanese Armed Forces (SAF) and the paramilitary Rapid Support Forces (RSF). According to the United Nations this has left over 25 million people dependent on

humanitarian assistance, whilst nearly 7.8 million people have been driven from their homes across Sudan, including 1.6 million forced to flee across its borders.

#### Latest Update

#### From the Church Association for Sudan and South Sudan

The war front has shifted south and westwards leaving the centre ravaged but relatively at peace.

However, a dramatic story is unfolding in the south west where three cities are under siege. One of them, El Fasher, with a population the size of the City of Bradford, is being walled in by the RSF. The rate at which the earthwork is being formed, they are about two months away from completing the encirclement. There is no safe passage out of the city: roads are blocked and those attempting to flee face attacks, extortion at checkpoints, community-based discrimination, and death.


