Pizza Praise

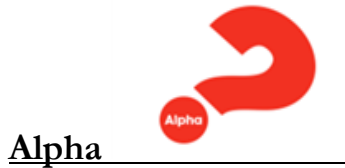
Please note that there is NO Pizza Praise on Sunday 25 January.

We had a great second session of the Alpha Course last Tuesday. Thank you for all your prayers!

It isn't too late for people to join the course – so please do invite (or remind) people.

Alpha works on the basis that St James Church hosts the course and we invite guests to attend. We then provide them with hospitality before we watch a video together and then discuss it.

Guests are encouraged to present their viewpoint in the discussion and they will be listened to. The way Alpha works is that everyone's point of view matters, and is heard. No-one has to say anything at all (but we hope they will). The point is that Alpha is a place where people can put their own point of view (whatever that is) in an honest, friendly and open environment – where they are listened to. This is why the reassurance that there is “no pressure, no follow up and no charge” is important. Anyone is free to leave the course at any time. So they have nothing to lose – and everything to gain!

Our Tuesday-night Alpha course session works like this:

7pm – guests arrive and enjoy some food

7.45pm – we watch this week's Alpha video together

8.15pm – discussion in small groups

8.45pm – guests depart

Can you provide practical help on a Tuesday evening at Alpha?

A big thank you to everyone who has said they will provide catering at the Alpha course. This element is such an important part of a successful Alpha.

With the number of guests we have we could do with some more volunteers to provide catering; and we could also do with some help with tidying up and washing up after the meal together.
